You won’t want to miss visiting these three state-recognized cultural districts:

Carmel Arts & Design District

Located in the heart of Old Town Carmel, the District is home to art galleries, specialty retail stores and the Indiana Design Center as well as events like the Carmel International Arts Festival, Art of Wine, and Second Saturday. If you can imagine the food, you can probably find it — from fine dining to authentic ethnic, rooftop bar to sidewalk cafe and everything in between.

Nickel Plate District

Located in Fishers (west of I-69 on 116th Street), the Nickel Plate District is a walkable mecca for diners, art enthusiasts and lovers of the great outdoors alike. Great food (even a “Test Kitchen” for burgeoning chefs!), award-winning brew pubs, live music and the Nickel Plate Trail converge in the heart of the city.

Noblesville Cultural Arts District

The Noblesville Cultural Arts District is tucked among the streets and alleys around the historic courthouse square. Local artists abound as Noblesville is home to the Hamilton County Artist’s Association, and their work displayed in numerous restaurants and retail outlets (and yes, for sale!). Dance to music in the park or on the courthouse lawn or enjoy intimate dinners in the alley under the twinkling lights.

Hotel Carmichael

Within the Carmel Arts & Design District, this 122-room luxury hotel is walkable to surrounding art destinations and boasts its own jazz nightclub and cabaret dinner and music venue. In addition, there is a 4,000 square foot conference area, a full-service restaurant, private dining and outdoor seating. Also nearby is the magnificent Center for Performing Arts and the Palladium, hosting national touring groups and home to local performing arts organizations including the Carmel Symphony Orchestra, Civic Theatre, Actors Theatre Indiana and the Indiana Wind Ensemble.

Renaissance Indianapolis North Hotel

Conveniently located along the Meridian Corridor, this Marriot hotel provides easy access to both Hamilton County and Indianapolis destinations. A modern and energetic design and numerous creative spaces blend a unique style with advanced technology. More than 12,000 square foot of exhibit space includes banquet and theatre capacity.

Drury Plaza Hotel Indianapolis Carmel

Boasting seven meeting rooms totaling more than 7,000 square feet, the Drury Plaza Hotel is located between Carmel and Indianapolis on Meridian St. (U.S. 31) on 96th Street. The hotel also has more than 300 sleeping rooms and nearly 40 suites.

Embassy Suites by Hilton Noblesville Indianapolis Conference Center

It's a "suite life" over at Hamilton County's largest conference center. Accommodating up 2,000 attendees for business and social events, 198 guest suites each include a sleeper sofa and kitchenette and access to an indoor pool, swanky lounge, and a fitness room.
